- **Application Form** – assessed against the application form and curriculum vitae. Applicants will not be asked to make a specific supporting statement. Educational qualifications will be “scored” as part of the shortlisting process.
- **Supporting Statements** - applicant are asked to provide a statement to demonstrate how they meet the criteria. The response will be “scored” as part of the shortlisting process.
- **Interview** – assessed during the interview process by either competency-based interview questions, tests, presentation etc.
